5.1 Wastewater Treatment Alternatives – Sewer Evaluation (D. Schilling)

Staff recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council amend the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget to allocate \$50,000 from the Sewer Collection Impact Fund (Fund #121) to cover the costs of services for technical assistance with engineering evaluations, determining financial feasibility and potential rate impacts associated with the evaluation of wastewater treatment alternatives.

Staff recommendation:

The City Attorney recommends that City Council authorize the City Attorney to prepare documents as necessary to: (1) amend Section 3.04.010 of the Wheatland Municipal Code to conform the purchasing policy with applicable legal requirements, and (2) amend Section 2.16.030 of the Wheatland Municipal Code to ensure that the City Manager is authorized to enter into contracts of employment with City staff.
