Recommendation

Receive progress report on completion of the Wheatland Flood Risk Reduction Feasibility Study

Background/Discussion

In May 2016 the City Council adopted Resolution 08-2016 approving an application to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) Small Community Flood Risk Reduction (SCFRR) Program. The purpose of the program is to help small communities conduct feasibility studies leading to the design and construction or implementation of flood risk reduction projects with proven feasibility. Wheatland was awarded \$500,000 to complete the project. The contract was executed on April 12, 2018 by the former City Manager and by DWR on July 26, 2018. The City Council approved a contract with MBK Engineers in September 2018 for completion of the project.

Work on the study is underway, and representatives of MBK Engineers will be present to provide a progress report and answer any questions you may have about the study.
