

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Wheatland will hold a public hearing on January 23, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. in the Wheatland Community Center, 101 C Street, Wheatland, CA 95692 to consider extending for an additional year the effective period of Ordinance No. 466, Urgency Interim Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Wheatland Adopting a Temporary Moratorium On All Commercial Marijuana Land Uses And All Outdoor Marijuana Cultivation in the City of Wheatland. If the City Council approves the extension of the urgency interim ordinance, then commercial marijuana land uses and outdoor cultivation of marijuana within the City of Wheatland would be prohibited for an additional period of ten months and fifteen days, from January 26, 2018 to December 11, 2018. This extension would permit the City staff, the Planning Commission and the City Council to continue to consider and evaluate whether and in what manner to permit the establishment and operation of commercial marijuana land uses and outdoor cultivation of marijuana within the City following the passage of Proposition 64, the Control, Regulate" and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act ("AUMA"); the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act ("MAVCRSA"); and the regulations adopted by the three state cannabis licensing authorities. The proposed ordinance, as well as Ordinance No. 466 and other supporting materials, are on file in the City Clerk's office and available for public review at Wheatland City Hall, 111 C Street, Wheatland, CA, 95692 during normal business days from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

All interested persons are invited to attend the public hearing and present written and/or oral comments on whether to extend the urgency ordinance and related issues. If you challenge the approval or extension of the ordinance in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code section 65090(b)).
