## CITY COUNCIL MEETING STAFF REPORT

Council discussion and consideration to adopt Resolution No. 24-23 authorizing the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Consolidated Engineering, Inc. and approve contract change orders for the City of Wheatland 2023 Pavement Maintenance Projects.

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends adoption of Resolution No. 24-23 (Attachment 1) which supersedes the previously adopted Resolution 20-23 (Attachment 2).

#### **Background/Discussion**

On June 13, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 20-23 authorizing the City Manager to enter into a contract with Consolidated Engineering, Inc. for construction of the 2023 Pavement Maintenance Projects (Project) in the amount of \$305,890.11. Consolidated Engineering's bid was the lowest of five bidders and well under the estimate for the Project.

However, Resolution 22-22 was in error in that it did not contain the customary language that also authorizes the City Manager to approve contract change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract amount or \$30,589.01. Change orders are used to approve additional work required due to unforeseen conditions that are discovered during construction as well as minor changes in the scope of work and minor differences between actual and estimated quantities.

#### **Alternatives**

Alternatively, the City Council may choose to not adopt the resolution and staff will attempt to construct the Project without the use of contingency funds.

#### Fiscal Impact

The low bid amount of \$305,890.11 plus contingency of \$30,589.01 (total of \$336,479.12) is well within the budgeted amount of \$468,400.00 for construction as outlined below.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CONSOLIDATED ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$305,890.11, AND APPROVE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED \$30,589.01 FOR THE CITY OF WHEATLAND 2023 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution 22-22 which established priorities for pavement maintenance activities including capital maintenance projects. The resolution identified projects on Hooper Street between Highway 65 and Olive Street, on Olive Street from Hooper Street to its westerly terminus, and on Main Street from E Street to the westerly terminus as priority projects for the expenditure of road maintenance funds; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 25, 2023, City staff presented a proposed capital pavement maintenance project to repair portions of Hooper Street, Olive Street, and Main Street including grinding and removing pavement, repairing subgrade failures, drainage modifications, new pedestrian ramps, pavement markings and other associated work ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 14-23 authorizing the City Manager to enter into funding agreements with Bishop Pumpkin Farm; Wheatland School District and Yuba County Office of Education; amending the FY 2022-23 Budget to include the Project; approving Bid Documents; and authorizing the City Manager to advertise the Project for bids; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 31, 2023, the bid period closed and the City received five bids for construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and determined that Consolidated Engineering, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$305,890.11; the low bid amount is within the budget established for construction of the Project; and therefore the City Engineer has recommended awarding a contract to Consolidated Engineering, Inc for construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 20-23 authorizing the City Manager to enter into a contract with Consolidated Engineering, Inc. for construction of the Project in the amount of \$305,890.11, however the resolution did not contain the customary language that also authorizes the City Manager to approve contract change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract amount or \$30,589.01.

- 2) The City Manager is authorized to enter into a construction contract with Consolidated Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$305,890.11 for construction of the City of Wheatland 2023 Pavement Maintenance Projects and authorized to approve contract change orders not to exceed \$30,589.01 for the City of Wheatland 2023 Pavement Maintenance Projects.
