Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Wheatland City Council consider approval of the attached Task Order #8 with Raney Planning and Management, Inc. to conduct the necessary tasks required to provide planning and environmental services for the 507 SR 65 Gas Station Conditional Use Permit (CUP) and Site Plan and Design Review Project (see Attachment 1). This action does not include any recommendations on the project itself. The proposed project will be brought to the Wheatland Planning Commission for review and consideration at a future date.

Background

The proposed project site is located at 507 State Route 65 on an approximate 2-acre undeveloped parcel. The project would include the development of a fuel canopy for a nine-island gas station, a 3,000 square foot convenience store and a 1,600 square foot quick-serve restaurant with a drive-thru. The project will require approval of a conditional use permit and site plan and design review.

Discussion

Acting as an extension of City staff, Raney Planning and Management, Inc. will review the application for completeness, assist with agency consultation, prepare staff reports and attend any required meetings and public hearings. The attached Task Order authorizes Raney Planning and Management, Inc. (the consultant) to perform the following tasks to process this project application:

- Project Initiation
- Planning Services
- Environmental Services
- Project Management

SCOPE OF WORK 507 STATE ROUTE 65 GAS STATION CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AND SITE PLAN AND DESIGN REVIEW PROJECT

Please find below Raney's scope of work, schedule, and budget for the 507 State Route (SR) 65 Gas Station Conditional Use Permit (CUP) and Site Plan and Design Review project.

PROJECT UNDERSTANDING

The project site is located at 507 SR 65 in the City of Wheatland, California. The approximately two-acre project site (APN 015-490-018) is undeveloped with scattered trees. Surrounding existing uses include single-family residences to the north; Union Pacific Railroad (UPPR) tracks, single-family residences, and commercial uses to the east, across SR 65; undeveloped land and single-family residences to the south; and single-family residences to the west, across Malone Avenue. The City of Wheatland General Plan designates the site as Commercial (C) and the project site is zoned as Heavy Commercial (C-3).

The proposed project would include the development of a fuel canopy for a nine-island gas station, a 3,000-square foot (sf) convenience store, and a 1,600-sf quick-serve restaurant with a drive-through. The gas station would include six fuel islands with 12 pumps stations and three diesel islands with six pumps stations. A total of 27 parking spaces would be included throughout the site and site access would be provided by two new driveways from SR 65 and Malone Avenue. The project will require the approval of a CUP and Site Plan and Design Review.

APPROACH

Raney's approach to environmental and planning services is to act as an extension of City staff to review the application for completeness, assist with agency consultation, prepare staff reports, and attend meetings and public hearings. Raney will coordinate extensively with City Departments to ensure a complete a thorough review of the application.

Based on Raney's preliminary analysis of the proposed project and conversations with the City, Raney proposes to prepare an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) to analyze the potential environmental effects associated with the proposed project. The IS/MND will be prepared using the checklist contained in Appendix G of the CEQA Guidelines and the standard City of Wheatland format. Raney anticipates that the potential impacts will be less-thansignificant; therefore, the appropriate CEQA document will be an IS/MND. Raney will work closely with City staff throughout the preparation of the IS/MND and determination of appropriate findings. The IS/MND will provide a discussion of the impacts related to implementation of the proposed project.

The following assumptions were used in the calculations:

- The cost for copying and printing is an estimate only and will be billed at cost.
- Additional meetings and hearings can easily be accommodated upon request and would be billed on a time-and-materials basis following Raney's standard billing rates.



• Raney expects that all work will be completed within the budgeted time. If additional time is necessary beyond that which has been budgeted due to unanticipated circumstances, those items will need to be renegotiated.

Factors that would increase the scope of work and estimated costs outlined in the proposal include: attendance at additional meetings and hearings, printing of additional copies of reports, analysis of additional issues beyond those discussed in this proposal or a more detailed level of analysis than described in this proposal, additional comments and subsequent revisions or responses to comments, changes in the project, and collection of data required beyond that described in this proposal. Raney would propose to renegotiate these items, if required, or charge on a time-and-materials basis.

SCHEDULE

The following tentative schedule is based on experience providing similar services. The schedule could be lengthened or shortened, depending on the needs of the City of Wheatland. Factors that could lengthen or shorten the schedule include dates of receipt of project information, length of document reviews, AB 52 requirements, changes in the project description, and unanticipated issues arising from City staff or the project team.
