### Recommendation

Receive and file the Quarterly Investment Report for the quarter ended June 30, 2023.

#### **Background**

The City's investment objectives are governed by State law and by the City's adopted Investment Policy. The Quarterly Investment Report provides information regarding the City's investments in accordance with the Investment Policy.

#### Discussion

The attached report for the quarter ended June 30, 2023, shows a summary of all cash and investment activity of the City. The City follows the practice of combining cash and investments for all funds. Except for the Pool Operations Fund, interest earned on combined cash and investments is allocated quarterly to the various funds based on the respective fund's cash balance. Interest earned on the cash balance in the Pool Operations Fund is calculated solely on LAIF (Local Agency Investment Fund) earnings. Total interest earnings for the quarter ended June 30, 2023, was \$86,690.35, a substantial increase of \$70,438.47 over the same quarter in 2022. Most of the City's idle cash is invested in LAIF. The LAIF interest rate for the quarter ending June 30, 2023, was 3.17%.

Cash activity during this April 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023 quarter included the receipt of \$377,078 in property tax revenues, developer impact fees of \$366,096 from the Caliterra development and reimbursements of \$579,513 from Yuba Water Agency for the regional sewer pipeline project and \$156,587 from the California Intergovernmental Risk Authority (CIRA) for the Little League Lights project. Significant expenditures included the semi-annual bond payment for the 2019 Revenue Refunding Bonds for the Water and Wastewater systems, \$245,831, and the purchase of a police vehicle, \$54,480.

As encouraged by the Council and allowed by the City's Investment Policy, some funds are now being invested in federally insured bank certificates of deposits (CDs). Three \$100,000 CDs have been purchased with Merchants Bank Carmel, maturing 10/10/2023, with an interest rate of 5.30%, US Bank National Association, maturing 1/8/2024, with an interest rate of 5.20%, and

Meridian Bank, maturing 6/21/2024, with an interest rate of 5.30%. A \$250,000 Federal Home Loan bond was purchased in July with a 7/26/2024 maturity with an interest rate of 5.50%. This investment will be included in future reports.

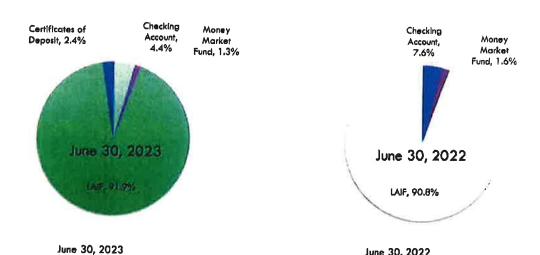
