## CITY COUNCIL MEETING STAFF REPORT

November 9, 2021

**SUBJECT:** Replace Police Chief's vehicle

**PREPARED BY:** Damiean Sylvester, Police Chief

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### **Recommendation**

Authorize the City Manager to spend up to \$67,000 to purchase and outfit a 2022 Ford Police Interceptor Utility AWD vehicle for use by the Police Department.

### **Background**

The City of Wheatland owns a variety of vehicles used for providing public safety services. A current list of police vehicles is shown below.

### **Discussion**

Staff is recommending Council approve replacing the Police Chief's vehicle. The Chief's current vehicle has over 138,000 miles and has unrepaired body damage from a previous traffic collision.

Price quotes were obtained from three local area Ford dealers: Geweke Ford, Folsom Ford and Future Ford. Folsom Ford met all the City's requirements at a cost of approximately \$48,179.44. An additional \$18,500 is being requested to outfit the vehicle with safety lighting, electronics, etc.

### **Alternatives**

1. Direct staff to purchase an alternative vehicle
2. Direct staff to not purchase a vehicle at this time

### **Fiscal Impact**

The vehicle will be paid for from the Supplemental Law Enforcement Fund (SLES Fund). SLES funds are received from the State's COPS program. The use of SLES funds is limited to supplementing front-line municipal police activities. In FY 2021, SLES revenue exceeded budget projections by \$67,000.
