SUBJECT: Update on Wheatland Community Pool Project

Recommendation

Receive update and provide comments on planning effort for Wheatland Community Pool Project. No action required.

Background/Discussion

On October 27, 2020 the City Council approved a contract with Melton Design Group (MDG) for assistance with park design projects and grant applications, including the proposed Wheatland Community Pool.

With assistance from MGD, four outreach meetings have been held (both live and via Zoom) to receive input from residents about the project. In addition, presentations have been made to both the Wheatland School District and the Wheatland Union High School District boards. Based on the input received, a conceptual design has been developed. Greg Melton will be present in the meeting to discuss the conceptual design and receive your feedback.

A final report including the preliminary design, construction cost estimates, and estimates of operational cost and cost recovery will be presented at the July 13 City Council meeting. If the City Council directs further action at that meeting, staff will proceed with completion of a \$3 million Prop 68 grant application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation to be submitted in November.
