#### Recommendation

Receive and file the Quarterly Investment Report for the quarter ended December 31, 2018.

### <u>Background</u>

The City's investment objectives are governed by State law and by the City's adopted Investment Policy. The Quarterly Investment Report provides information regarding the City's investments in accordance with the Investment Policy.

### **Discussion**

The attached report for the quarter ended December 31, 2018 shows a summary of all cash and investments of the City, the cash balance for each fund, and the cash activity for each fund. The City follows the practice of pooling cash and investments for all funds. Interest earned on pooled cash and investments is allocated quarterly to the various funds based on the respective fund's cash balance. Interest earnings for the quarter ended December 31, 2018 was \$38,713.44.

The General Fund cash balance includes \$800,000 that is reserved for the possible reallocation of contingent sales tax. The Water Fund cash balance includes a reserve of \$171,190 and the Sewer Fund cash balance includes a reserve of \$205,808. The Water and Sewer Fund reserves are required by the US Department of Agriculture as part of the City's loan agreements.

The large deposit in *Fund 142 SLES* includes the first quarter of FY 2019 and the final payment for FY 2018. The large deposit in *Fund 143 Pumpkin Patch Joint* reflects the admission fee received from Bishop's Farm for the July through December 2018 period. All other funds reflect normal activity.

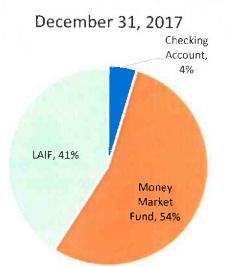

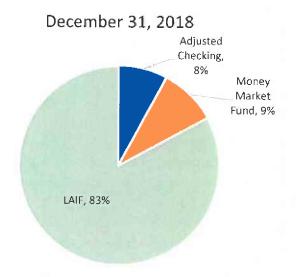
