Recommendation

Approve the Resolution to submit the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Fiscal Year 2018-2019 claim to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG).

Background/Discussion

SACOG is the designated regional transportation planning agency responsible for administering the TDA funds for the counties of Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, Yuba and the cities and transit operators therein.

The TDA provides two major sources of public transportation funding in California – Local Transportation Fund (LTF) and State Transit Assistance (STA). LTF funds, generated from a ¼ cent retail sales tax, are apportioned to eligible local agencies based generally on population. The City's apportionment for fiscal year 2018-2019 is \$73,764 of which \$2,213 will be kept by SACOG for administration. STA funds, generated from taxes on diesel fuel, are apportioned to eligible agencies based on population and transit operator revenues. The City's STA funds are, by contract, apportioned 100% directly to the Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority.

The attached resolution authorizes staff to file the TDA claim for the City's fiscal year 2018-2019 apportionment.

Alternatives

The alternative is to not submit the claim.

Fiscal Impact

If the claim is submitted the City will receive \$71,551 to be used for street maintenance projects. In fiscal year 2017-2018, the City received \$54,850.
