Recommendation

Adopt Resolution 26-19 establishing the Master Fee Schedule as of July 1, 2019.

Background/Discussion

A municipality is authorized to establish reasonable fees for services rendered, provided that those fees do not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of providing the service for which the fee is charged. The City of Wheatland has established fees by authority of the Municipal Code, City Ordinances, City Resolutions, City development/funding agreements, and State and Federal statute.

In government, the difference between a fee and a tax is that a fee is paid by an individual for a specific good or service rendered by the government that benefits only that individual, while a tax has only a general connection to the benefits received for an individual.

The attached Master Fee Schedule ("Schedule") has been updated to reflect the fees in place as of July 1, 2019. Building Fees and Garbage Fees have been removed from the Schedule since their fees are now set by contract with Yuba County and Recology respectfully. The Schedule will be posted on the City's website making it easier for citizens, staff, and interested parties to understand and access the City's various fees. The attached redlined version of the Schedule adopted August 2018 shows the changes that have been made to the fee amounts and descriptions.

Certain fees are automatically increased each year based on either the change in the consumer price index (CPI) or the change in the engineering news record construction cost index (ENR). Depending on the fee, the increase is either the beginning of the fiscal year (July 1), the beginning of the calendar year (January 1), or on October 1.

The attached Resolution 26-19 reflects fees in effect on July 1, 2019 and directs staff to adjust the following fees on the dates indicated per previously adopted resolutions and ordinances:

- Water and Sewer rates (Oct 1, 2019)
- Fire Protection Facilities fee (Jan 1, 2020)
- Impact fees (Jan 1, 2020)
- Planning and Engineering fees (Jan 1, 2020)

Other fees are updated as needed to ensure that fees charged are sufficient to recover the cost of services provided. These fee adjustments will be presented for Council approval as necessary. The FOG (fats, oil, grease) fee and the Sign fees were increased on July 1, 2019 per resolutions 21-09 and 16-10.

RESOLUTION NO. 26-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEATLAND ADOPTING THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019

WHEREAS, a municipality is authorized to establish reasonable fees for services rendered, provided that those fees do not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of providing the service for which the fee is charged (Government Code Sections 66000-66018.5); and,

WHEREAS, in addition to fees and charges identified in the City's Municipal Code, the City Council of the City of Wheatland has adopted Ordinances 339, 384, 400, 448, Resolutions 10-93, 33-01, 38-03, 18-04, 39-04, 43-04, 28-05, 01-07, 07-07, 06-08, 21-09 06-10, 16-10, 15-12, 01-13, 04-19, 09-19, 10-19 and development agreements that establish fees for services rendered by the City for administration, planning, building, business license, code enforcement, public works, park and recreation, public safety, water, sewer, and development impact fees; and.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to modify the previously adopted fees to ensure that fees charged are reasonably related to the estimated cost of providing the service:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheatland as follows:

- 1. <u>Fee Schedule</u>. The fees for administration, planning, building, business license, code enforcement, public works, park and recreation, public safety, water, sewer, and development impact fees are those set forth in the City of Wheatland Master Fee Schedule attached as Attachment 1 herein.
- October 1, 2019 Updates. The Master Fee Schedule shall be updated on October 1, 2019 to reflect adjustments to water and sewer fees based on Resolutions 09-19 and 10-19.
- 3. <u>January 1, 2020 Updates</u>. The Master Fee Schedule shall be updated on January 1, 2020 to reflect adjustments to Fire Protection Facilities, Impact Fees, and Planning and Engineering Fees based on Resolutions 01-07, 06-08, 15-12, and Ordinances 400 and 448.
- 4. <u>Authority of City Manager to Prescribe Additional Regulations</u>. The City Manager may adopt such regulations and prescribe such forms as are necessary to implement and collect the fees provided for by this resolution.
- The fees established by this resolution are in conformance with previously adopted ordinances, resolutions, agreements, and the City's Municipal Code as they relate to fees and charges.
