In July 2019, the City of Wheatland received a generous \$1 million donation for the operation and maintenance of a future Wheatland community pool to be built within 7 years. An Ad-hoc Committee with representatives from the City of Wheatland, Wheatland School District and Wheatland High School District has been formed to work on the project and seek funding through a State Recreation and Tourism Grant available this year. In the coming weeks, the community will have several opportunities to learn about the project and share ideas both in person and via ZOOM. This series of public meetings will be conducted by the City's consultant, Melton Design Group, to determine overall community support for the project, define features and project both construction and operational costs. It is crucial for a successful grant application that we gain a broad range of community input, capture your innovative ideas, and develop a plan inclusive to the whole community. The final report is expected to come to the City Council in June. At that point the City Council will evaluate how to move forward with the project.
