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FAQs for Wheatland GPU RFP

The City of Wheatland is seeking proposals from qualified consultants to complete the City's General Plan Update. All proposals are due to Jim Goodwin by June 16, 2023. Below are questions and responses regarding the RFP.

1) Does the City have an anticipated budget for updating the General Plan?

Response: No, the City is looking for the most appropriate product that meets the needs of the rural community of Wheatland for a fair price.

2) Is there an anticipated timeline for completion for the project?

Response: Anticipated for completion by the end of 2024.

3) Was an EIR prepared for the recent Housing Element Update?

Response: The City prepared a program level Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Sixth Cycle Housing Element, which can be accessed at:
