

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEATLAND  
ADOPTING THE POLICY ON DISCONNECTION OF RESIDENTIAL WATER  
SERVICE FOR NONPAYMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is charged with notifying utility customers of the amount due for their monthly water usage; and,

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill (SB) 998 was signed into law on September 28, 2018 and must be implemented by municipal water systems by April 1, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, SB 998 requires specific disconnection notification requirements, prohibits services from being disconnected under specified circumstances, and must be available in hard copy and on the City's website in prescribed languages; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 998 requires public water systems that supply water to more than 200 service connections to have a written policy that addresses the requirements listed above.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Wheatland does hereby adopt the City of Wheatland Disconnection of Residential Water Service for Nonpayment Policy as described in Attachment A.
