Wheatland Fire Authority personnel are committed to the following values in our interactions with coworkers and citizens.

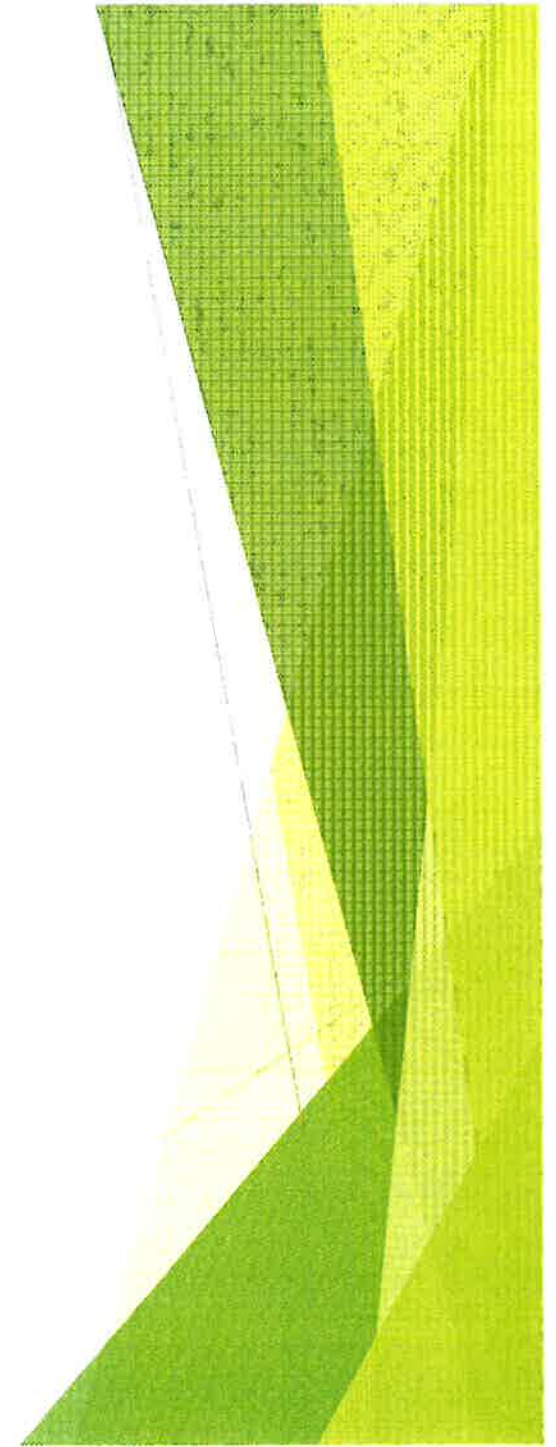


# Core Values

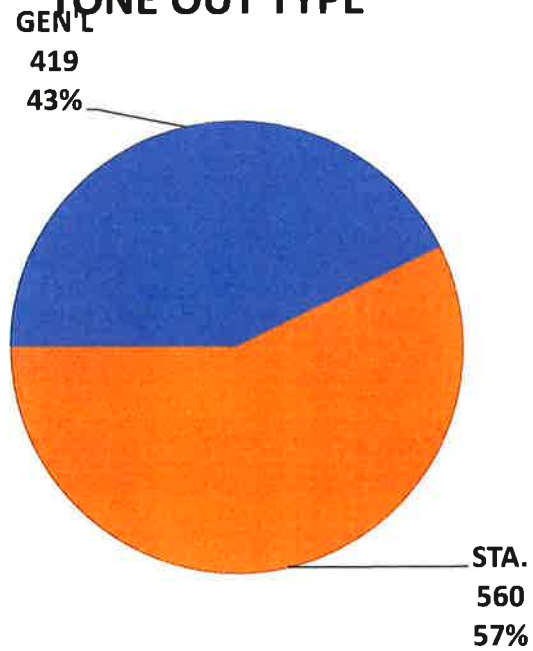

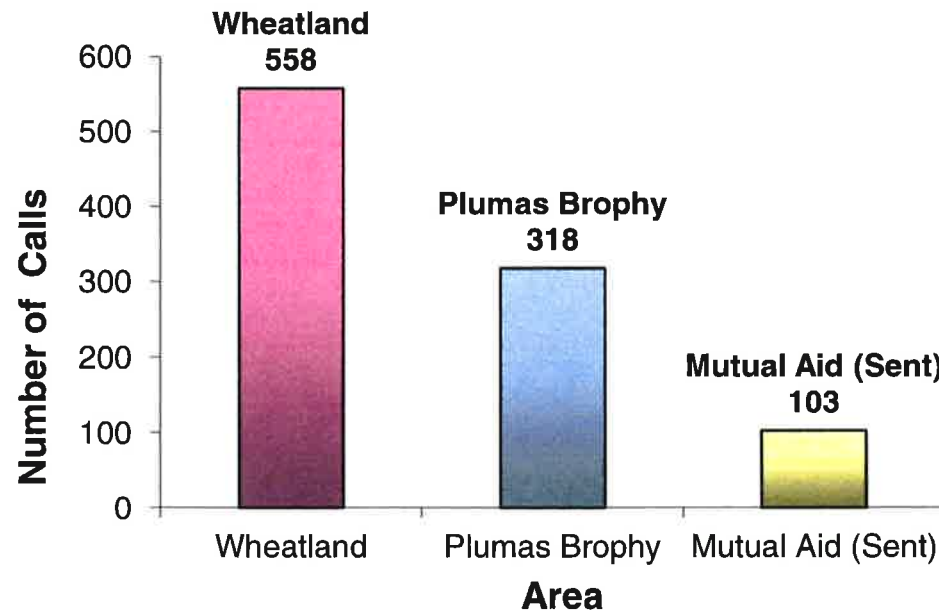

## 2019 WHEATLAND FIRE AUTHORITY TONE OUT TYPE



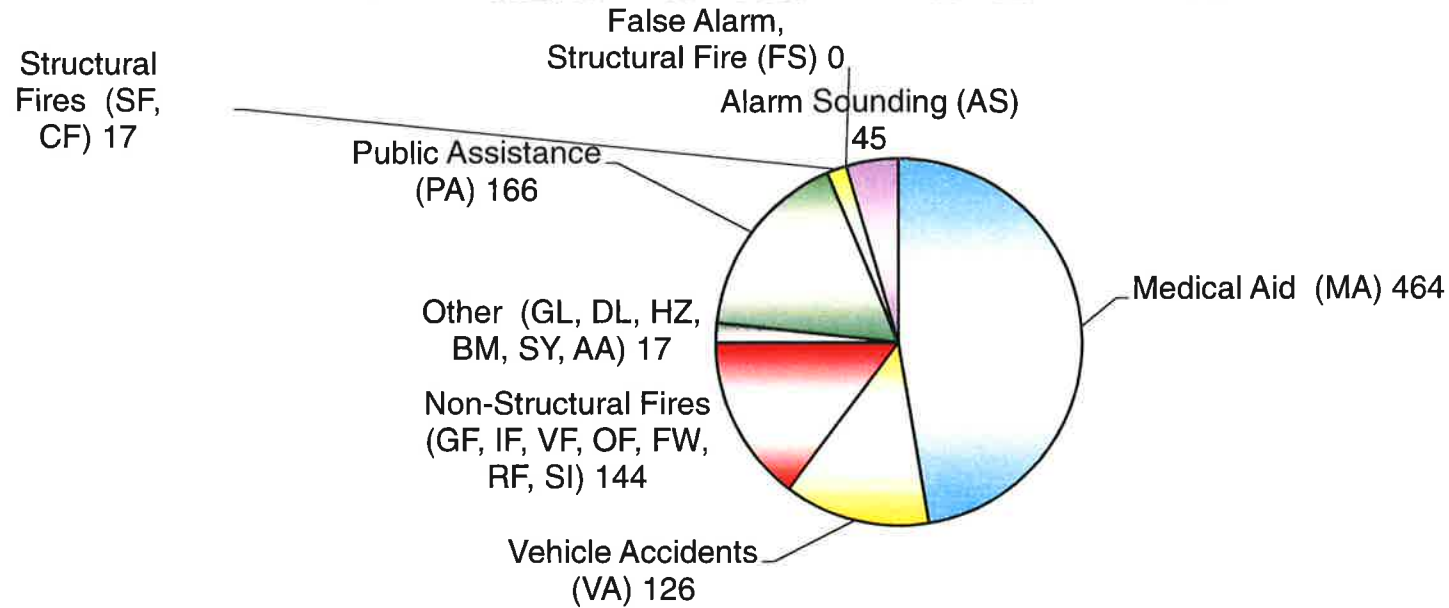

**2019 Wheatland Fire Authority Calls by Area**



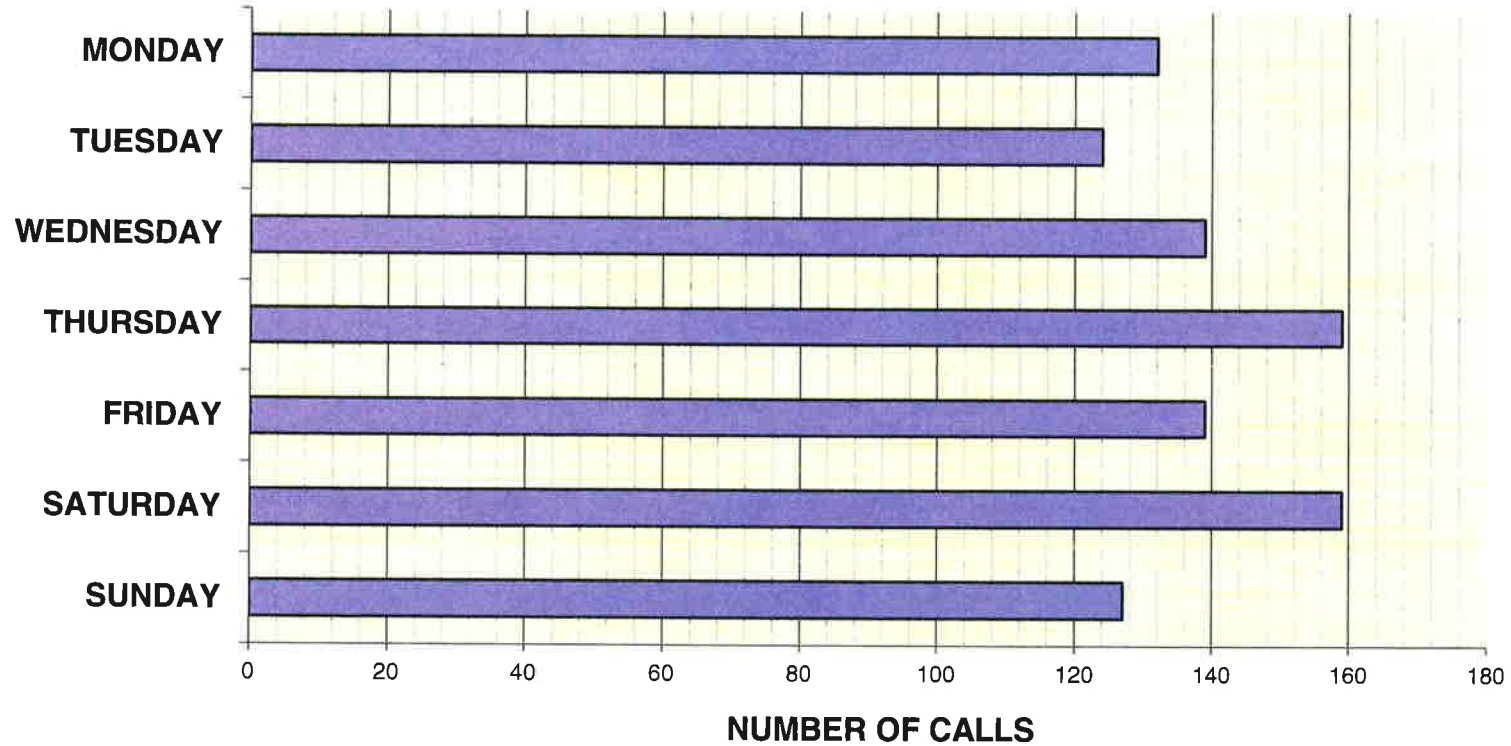

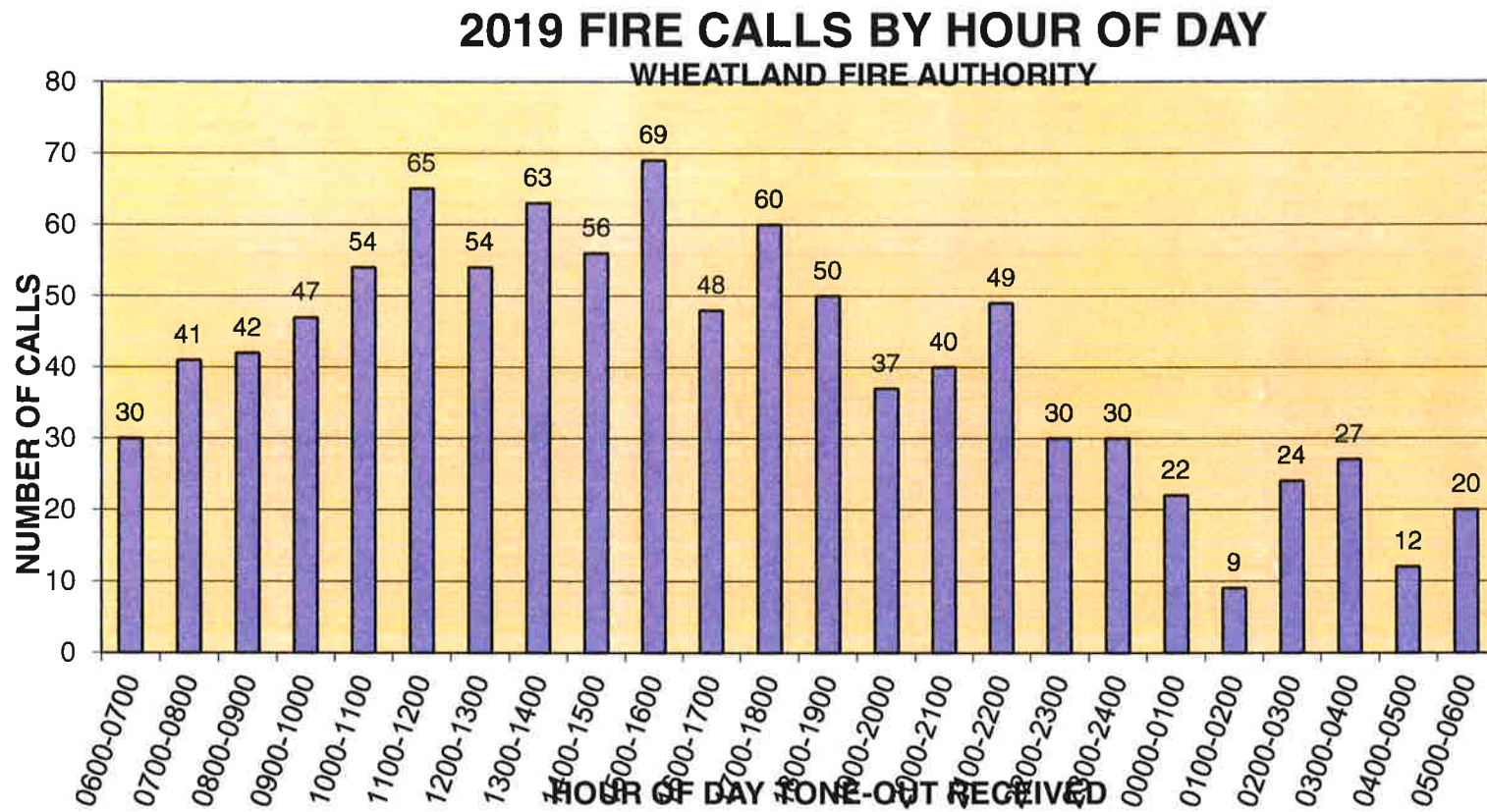

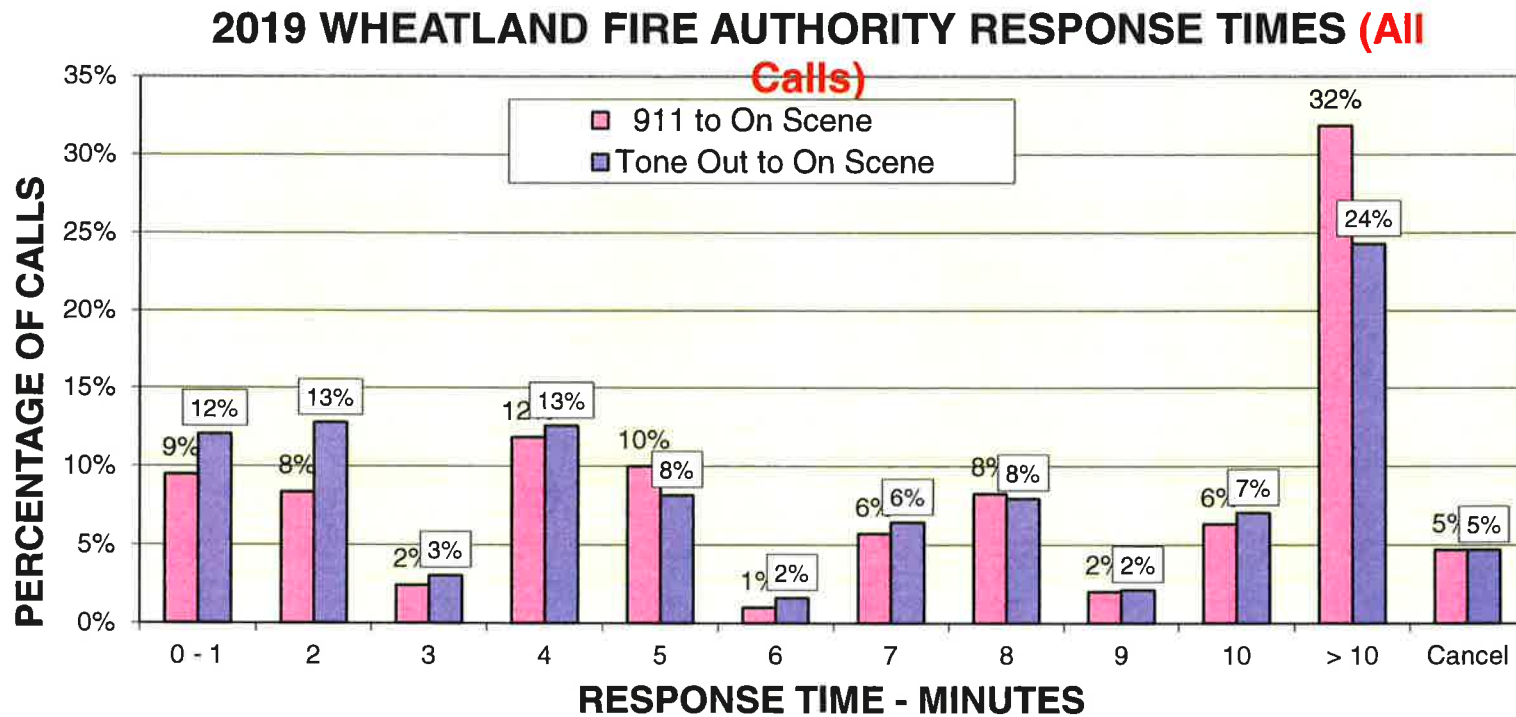

CALLS BY DAY OF WEEK**



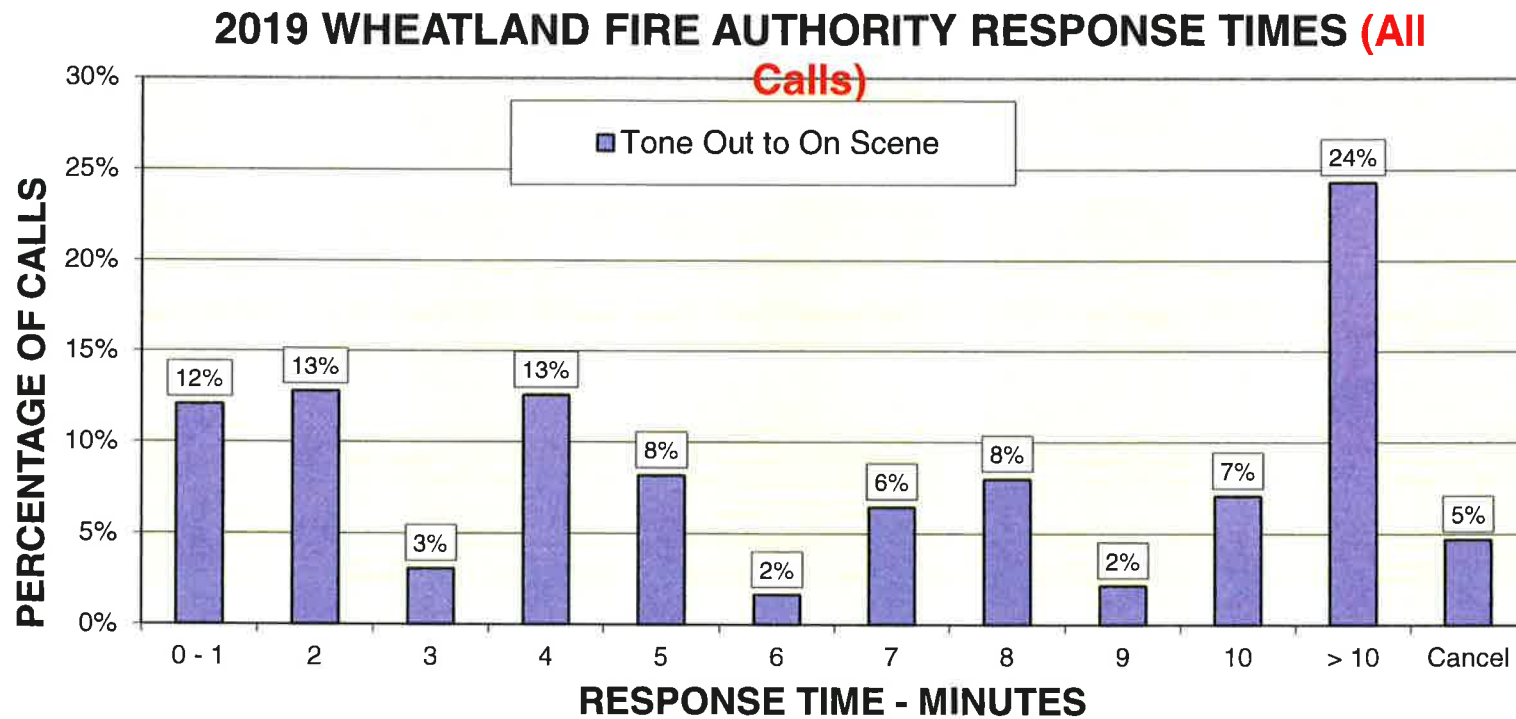

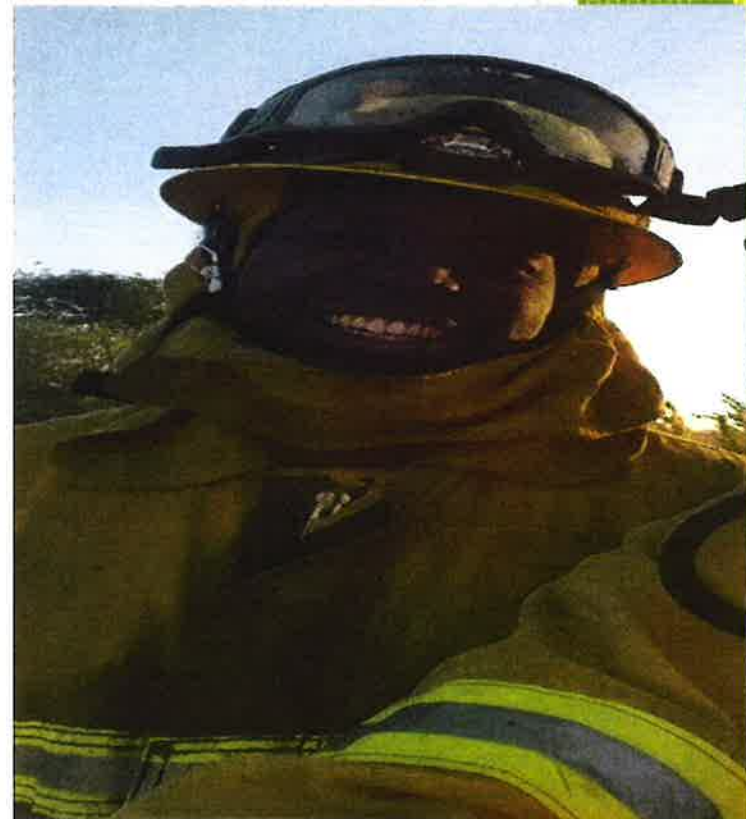
